

## The Wattage Game Introduction & Instructions

Understanding how much energy individual household items use and how much that costs, can help people to reduce their energy consumption.

This game was originally designed as a guess the wattage exercise and can still be used that way, but we have also developed a version which shows the cost of each appliance so that participants can make sensible choices around energy efficiency.

1. This game can be delivered as a powerpoint but works better if the pictures are reproduced onto card (A3 or bigger!!)
2. Cards should be produced with the picture on one side and the answer on the back.
3. There are a number of ways to play the game;
  - a. "Play Your Cards Right" style with participants answering higher or lower.
  - b. Picture cards and separate answer labels distributed with participants being required to match the right answer to the picture.
  - c. As a 'multiple choice' presentation where participants can shout out their answers.
